compliance programs. The meeting featured insights from Ronald Kiima, former Assistant Chief Accountant with the SEC's Division of Corporate Finance. The firm plans to host more workshops in December with roundtable sessions in Costa Mesa and San Diego.

"Navigating the SEC's review process requires a comprehensive understanding of what triggers these reviews and how to adequately prepare for them," said Wayne Pinnell, managing partner of Haskell & White.
