Haskell and White hosts SEC roundtable series

The Irvine-based accounting firm will host multiple workshops about the SEC's compliance programs.

Irvine-based Haskell and White, an independently owned accounting, auditing and tax consulting firm, held a roundtable discussion on Sept.

8 to address the Security and Exchange Commission's (SEC) oversight and compliance programs. The meeting featured insights from Ronald Kiima, former Assistant Chief Accountant with the SEC's Division of Corporate Finance. The firm plans to host more workshops in December with roundtable sessions in Costa Mesa and San Diego.

Key points discussed in the presentation include mandatory and discretionary review triggers, full reviews versus limited scope reviews and other issues.
